Air Ambulance Minimum Requirements

CHECKLIST

- All aircraft are approved for commercial use by the Civil Aviation Authority (“CAA”) and have an Air Operator Certificate (“AOC”) for commercial flights.
- All aircraft are flown with 2 pilots.
- The pilots are commercial pilot’s with up-to-date commercial pilots licences (“ATPL or CPL”)
- The pilots are “type rated” for the aircraft they are flying.
- The pilots have not exceeded their legal crew duty hour limitations.
- The company is a member of and is governed by the bodies governing the aviation industry (e.g. BACA, TIACA, BHAH).
- The company has been awarded an ISO 9001 standard for quality control.
- The company is NHS approved and NHS audited.
- The company provides a genuine 24 hour service.
- The service is a full bed to bed transfer including ground ambulances.
- The service includes arranging hospital admission.
- All costs are included – de icing, handling agents, airport extensions and out of hours and taxes.
